Emergency Housing And Assistance Program Capital Development (EHAPCD) 2011-2012 Notice Of Funding Availability (NOFA)

On August 15, 2011, the State of California Housing and Community Development (HCD) released a Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) for its statewide Emergency Housing and Assistance Program Capital Development (EHAPCD). EHAPCD funds are deferred loans for capital development purposes for sites that provide emergency shelters, transitional housing and/or safe havens for homeless individuals and families.

Eligible Applicants: HCD will award EHAPCD deferred loans, which may be forgiven, to eligible local government agencies or California nonprofits that provide or contract with community organizations to provide qualifying emergency shelter, transitional housing, and/or safe haven to homeless persons.

Submission Deadline: **Applications are due on Friday, September 30, 2011 at 5:00 p.m.** Applications must be mailed or delivered to:

Available Funding: While \$20 million is available for 2011-2012 statewide funding, \$16 million has been allocated to urban counties. An applicant may be involved in multiple applications; however, the total of these applications cannot exceed \$1 million per county.

Local Priorities: Applicants in Los Angeles County should contact their Designated Local Board (DLB) immediately to obtain the locally required priorities, which must be submitted as the Priorities portion of the EHAPCD application.
