

### APPENDIX F.3. SANTA MONICA CITY DATA ON SENIOR HOMELESS

Data excerpted from City of Santa Monica City Council Report for January 10, 2006. The report discussed eligibility criteria for the Senior Homeless Prevention and Rental Assistance Program funded by the Redevelopment Agency (RDA).

Based on the data below that detailed the senior homeless clients' documented conditions, Santa Monica City's Human Services Division staff recommended that the City Council approved a program that would provide RDA funded rental assistance to 65 very-low income Santa Monica based homeless people who were 55 years old and older and had received City funded homeless services for a minimum of one year through the Coordinated Case Management (CCM) system.<sup>1</sup>

<sup>1</sup> In addition, City staff recommended that 80 very-low income Santa Monica households, whose head of households were 55 years old or older, and who were at imminent risk of homeless, be provided with a one-time homelessness prevention grant, not to exceed \$2,000.
